

## Jefferson County School System Goals 2022-2023

Many parents signed school parent compacts in September and October 2022 for the 2022-23 school year based on these goals. Thank you for pledging to work with us to achieve our goals.

### District Goals

- Decrease the achievement gap between the highest performing subgroup and all other subgroups in all grade levels and content areas by 3% of potential growth or the state assessments.
- Create a healthy and restorative school climate that uses restorative approaches to address conflict in schools and meets the needs of the whole child as measured by school climate ratings.
- Create an evaluation system that focuses on progress and outcomes that monitors program effectiveness in all special education environments.
- Increase teacher retention in an effort to improve teacher effectiveness and to increase potential leader.

### Louisville Academy Goals

- Improve scores on Georgia Milestones in all content areas by 3% (or more) of potential growth in the ranges of Proficient and Distinguished.
- Create a positive and restorative school climate as reflected by 3% potential growth on school climate surveys.
- Improve performance of SPED students on Georgia Milestones Alternative Assessments by 3% of potential growth in Proficient and Distinguished

### Carver Elementary School Goals

- Increase student learning in Reading and Mathematics by 3% of potential growth/gain as measured by Acadience and Georgia Milestones.
- To create a consistent writing process that will increase student achievements on Writescore by 3% of potential growth.
- Cultivate a learning environment that will use PBIS and Restorative Practices to improve climate and culture ratings of the school.

### Wrens Elementary School Goals

- There will be an increase of 3% potential growth of students scoring at the Proficient and Distinguished Level on the Georgia Milestones in ELA.
- There will be an increase of 3% potential growth of students scoring at the Proficient and Distinguished Level on the Georgia Milestones in Mathematics.
- We plan to equip our staff to better serve our changing population of students.

### JCMS Goals

- SPED Achievement scores will grow 3% on IXL, Beacon, and Growth measure in ELA and Math
- Regular use of formative data to increase student achievement in ELA and Math by 3% of potential growth
- Implement STEAM to increase science scores by 3% of potential growth

### JCHS Goals

- Increase by at least 3%, the number of students performing at the proficient level on Georgia Milestones in all areas by improving pedagogical practices and skills
- Show a 3% increase on school culture that is positive and restorative
- Implement the 4 major components of clarity with fidelity to ensure that students know what they are learning, why they are learning it, and how they have learned it.
