District Goals

- Decrease the achievement gap between the highest performing subgroup and all other subgroups in all grade levels and content areas by 3% of potential growth or the state assessments.
- Create a healthy and positive school culture and climate that uses collaborative problem-solving approaches to address conflict in schools and meets the needs of the whole child as measured by school climate ratings.
- Create an evaluation system that focuses on progress and outcomes that monitors program effectiveness in all special education environments.
- Increase teacher retention in an effort to improve teacher effectiveness and to increase potential leader pool.

Louisville Academy Goals

- Improve scores on Georgia Milestones in all content areas by 3% (or more) of potential growth in the ranges of Proficient and Distinguished.
- Create a positive and restorative school climate as reflected by 3% potential growth on school climate surveys.
- •Improve performance of SPED students on Georgia Milestones Alternative Assessments by 3% potential growth in Proficient and Distinguished

Carver Elementary School Goals

- Increase student learning in Reading and Mathematics by 3% potential growth/gain as measured by i-Ready and Georgia Milestones.
- To create a consistent writing process that will increase student achievements on Write Score by 3% potential growth.
- Cultivate a learning environment that will use PBIS and Restorative Practices to improve climate and culture ratings of the school.

JCMS Goals

- Implement STEAM to increase science scores by 3% potential growth.
- Reimplement the advisement program to address the social and emotional needs of students for increased academic success.
