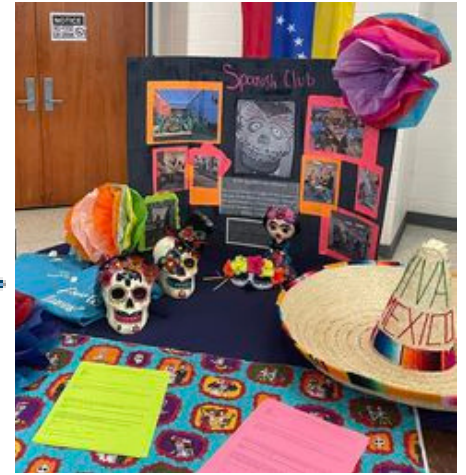

Science, I love learning about animals and sea life.

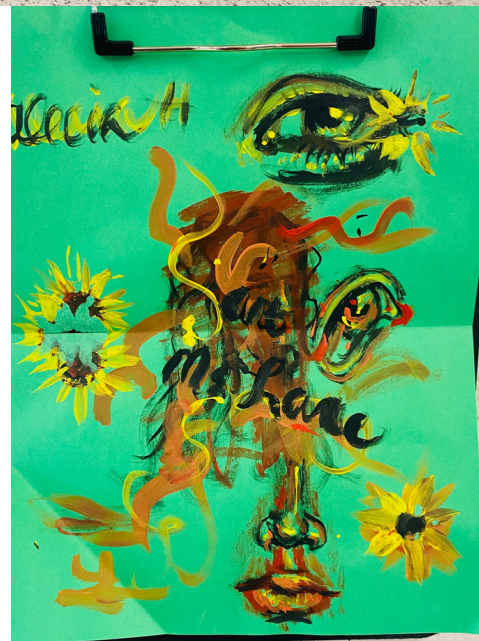

Changing the \$50 Bill

Imagine this, removing Ulysses S. Grant and replacing him with Andrew Johnson. Well that's the case here, there's an argument where people want to replace Grant with Reagan. From the article "Time to change the 50 Dollar Bill"; people argue that Reagan "ended the cold war and threats from the Soviet Union." but I disagree because Ronald Reagan is responsible for many scandals attributed to his administration-Iran-Contra- and Arms for Hostages. Reagan work was weak in the war on terrorism, after he vowed to hunt and penalize them, he failed to deliver. Grant had many achievements including his work to freed slaves and Native Americans. Also leading the Union troops to victory, forcing the Confederacy to surrender.

To start with, Ronald Reagan had a bad history. He boldly supplied weapons to Saddam Hussein's Iraq during the Iran-Iraq war, fully aware of Iraq use of chemical weapons against innocent civilians in clear defiance of international law, and this is cited from "U.S secretly Gave aid to Iraq Early in its war Against Iran: The New York Times". Despite global condemnation of Saddam's chemical attacks on Kurds, Reagan supplied Iraq with weapons and intel, vetoing UN censure Reagan authorize the CIA to establish the Contras, whom he called "Freedom Fighters" despite their violent tactics and desire to overthrow the democratically elected government. Following the abduction of numerous American citizens by terrorists in Lebanon, President Reagan authorized the provision of arms to Iran as a means of securing their release. Regrettably, this concession failed to prevent further hostage-taking incidents. You would think that this is something that happens once but, following the deployment of troops to Beirut for peacekeeping purposes, President Reagan's decision was met with a terrorist attack that resulted in the death of 241 U.S Marines. In response, Reagan acquiesced to the terrorists demand by withdrawing all troops from Beirut

Next, the opposite side may state Reagan lower taxes put money back into people's pocket. People who argue that Reagan should be on the 50 dollar bill turn their eye to the scandals of Reagan Administration to Iran-Contra and Arms for Hostages. From being behind many scandals to supplying weapons to Hussein Iraq. Grant led this country to a great place. Leading the Union troop to victory forcing the Confederacy to surrender.
