

VACANCY NOTICE School Psychologist

The Jefferson County School System is seeking a qualified candidate to fill the position of School Psychologist for the District. Jefferson County is a rural district located in the Central Savannah River Area of Georgia. Three elementary, one middle and one high school serve a student body of approximately 2,300.

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES, AND SKILLS:

The School Psychologist must professionally maintain highly confidential information. This position requires one to be regularly, predictably and reliably at work. The ability to work well with students, parents, staff, and the community is necessary. High integrity, excellent character, and a good professional reputation are essential. The School Psychologist must be able to perform tasks involving sitting for prolonged periods. Vision, hearing and verbal communication are essential functions in performing required tasks, duties and responsibilities.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Specialist's degree or above is required in School Psychology.
2. Candidates must be certified in or eligible for certification in School Psychology.
