Reading -Students are learning to read from left to right while tracking each word with their finger.

Phonics: Have your child practice writing all of the letters of the alphabet and give each sound the letter makes. Students should be able to recognize all 52 letters and 21 consonant sounds.

Fry Words: Please study Fry Words daily. Our goal is to know at least 50 sight words by December.

First (initial) sounds: Students should be able to say the first sound they hear in a word, such as /c/ cat. They should also be able to change the first letter to make a new word. Ex. Change b in ball to c and you have the word call.

Writing- Students are learning to dictate (tell) and draw a narrative about an important event that has taken place in their life.

Math- Count daily. The goal is to count from 0 to 100.
Practice counting backwards from 10 to 0.
Practice counting by 10s to 100.
Students should be able to recognize numbers 0-20 out of order.

Social Studies: I can name the rules and tell why rules are important.
